



Commissioning Supervisor

Certification proves the professional is competent and trained in the HVAC systems commissioning to be performed, which will meet SMACNA standards and which will provide more benefits to consumers.

Building commissioning, in the broadest sense, is the process of achieving, verifying and documenting the performance of a building and its various systems to ensure it meets the specifications and needs of the owner and occupants

Studies have proven that consumers have a higher comfort level when certified professionals are used. Certification isn't easy. It isn't just a piece of paper. Certification is something to work towards, that carries with it many rewards. Being a "Certified Professional" opens doors.

Certification is a statement that the Certified Commissioning Supervisor has met TABB's strict standards for certification. The aim of these standards is to ensure that Certified Commissioning Supervisors are competent, reliable and qualified professionals.

Are you eligible? To qualify for the ICB/TABB Commissioning Supervisor Certification Exam, the applicant must meet one of the following eligibility criteria: A college/university degree in engineering with at least one year's experience in HVAC installation or design work; OR, a two (2) year associate degree in HVAC with at least three (3) years experience in HVAC installation or design work; OR, is an ITI certified TAB technician and has a minimum of five (5) years experience in HVAC installation or design work (which may include apprenticeship), at least one year of which must be in testing, adjusting and balancing; OR, has at least five (5) years' experience in testing, adjusting and balancing work and is recommended in writing for the Exam by the applicant's employer. The employer must be eligible to be an ICB/TABB Certified Contractor, except only for the requirements to employ an ICB/TABB Certified Technician and/or an ICB/TABB Certified Supervisor.
