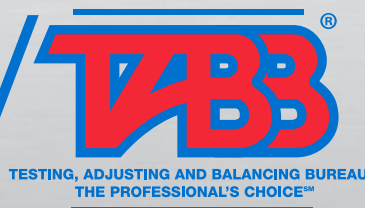


ANSI ACCREDITATION: THE PERFORMANCE ASSURANCE

ANSI (American National Standards Institute) is a private nonprofit organization that has overseen the development of voluntary consensus standards for products, services, processes, systems, and personnel in the U.S. for nearly a century. It accredits processes developed by organizations, such as the ICB (International Certification Board), which provides certified HVAC professionals to the industry.

An increasing number of engineers, architects, general contractors, and government entities are mandating proof of qualifications. ICB-certified technicians and supervisors are the first and only ANSI-accredited HVAC fire life safety professionals in the HVAC industry.

- Expands the bidders' pool for qualified HVAC contractors
- Positions ICB as a leader in meeting specification requirements
- ICB is required by ANSI to undergo an annual impartial and independent audit
- Sustains continual improvement through yearly exam reviews
- Requires valid, reliable and defensible exams
- Established knowledge bases promote consistency across the certification process



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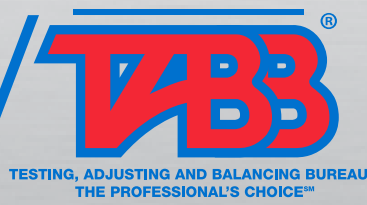


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
