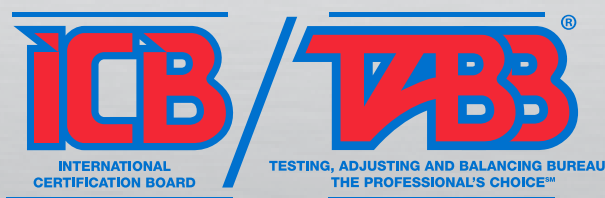


ANSI ACCREDITATION: THE PERFORMANCE ASSURANCE

ANSI (American National Standards Institute) is a private nonprofit organization that has overseen the development of voluntary consensus standards for products, services, processes, systems, and personnel in the U.S. for nearly a century. It accredits processes developed by organizations, such as the ICB (International Certification Board), which provides certified HVAC professionals to the industry.

An increasing number of engineers, architects, general contractors, and government entities are mandating proof of qualifications. ICB-certified technicians and supervisors are the first and only ANSI-accredited TAB and HVAC fire life safety professionals in the HVAC industry.

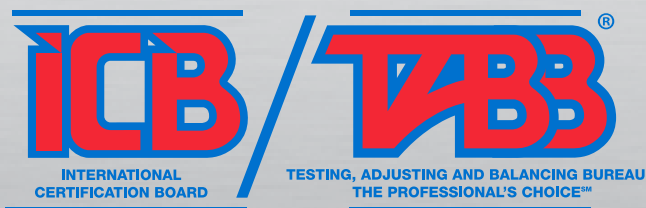
