Air quality is represented by concentrations of pollutants and thermal (temperature and relative humidity) conditions that affect the health, comfort, and performance of occupants. ICB certified HVAC professionals assure that building HVAC systems support acceptable IAQ.

According to BCC Research the U.S. market for indoor air quality (IAQ) was valued at nearly \$10 billion, and is projected to grow at nearly 5% annually. Over half of the IAQ market is in services.
